SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

Recommended submissions length for the paper is a maximum of 4 pages using ACM Template, including figures and references. Paper submissions will be accepted until specified deadline and must be provided using Adobe Acrobat PDF. Papers should be written in English and submitted online via the sciencesconf link provided below.

The cover page should indicate whether it is a research or an experience paper. It should include paper title, abstract, list of keywords indicating the paper's topic area (preferably from the conference topic list), author's full names, affiliations and complete addresses, telephone numbers and electronic mail addresses.

All paper submissions will be carefully reviewed by at least two experts and returned to the author(s) with comments to ensure the high quality of the accepted papers. The authors of the submitted papers will receive suggested modifications early enough in the process to revise their papers. All VNU Msc students that are authors of submitted papers must present their contributions during the dedicated VNU Msc students sessions of the ADVANCE workshop scheduled on Wednesday 28th February 2024.

Electronic submission via the Web is mandatory (**sciencesconf**). Authors are requested to submit their papers in **PDF** format – ACM Template ("sigconf template")*.
